Role Summary

Assist the Technical Team Leader in managing technical support for teaching research and Enterprise in the School of Environmental Sciences, principally in Geoscience.

Principal Accountabilities

- 1. Direct supervision of technicians in Geoscience based at KR to ensure prioritizing and allocation of technical support work for practical classes, research, academic enterprise and outreach activities within Geoscience
- 2. Assist the Technical Team Leader in planning, development, management, delivery and maintenance of high quality technical support pertaining to Geoscience.
- 3. Act as the key point of contact between technicians in the area and the academic staff, referring issues to the Technical Team Leader
- 4. Principal responsibility for raising Purchase Order Requests and monitoring delivery and invoicing of goods in the area.
- 5. Assist the technical Team Leader in monitoring of budgets in the area
- 6. Deputise for the Technical Team Leader in Environmental Sciences as appropriate
- 7. Ensure compliance on all matters relating to health and safety including those relating to any person working, studying or visiting the areas managed
- 8. Provide technical support in Geosciences (principally Geology)
- 9. Provide technical support backup for the Scanning Electron Microscope under the guidance of the Technical Team Leader and SEM manager
- 10. Demonstrate in student practicals, including field work as required by the Technical Team

Leader

- 11. Maintenance and upkeep of equipment and laboratories in Geoscience
- 12. Participating in Discipline and School, groups and committees
- 13. Engaging in external professional networks and keeping up to date with knowledge and developments in the sector relevant to service planning and delivery
- 14. Undertaking any other duties as required in agreement with the Technical Manager


